DMS graduates are given the opportunity to move on to the MBA, which is offered through a franchise programme with Liverpool John Moores University.

Professional Development Programmes

The PDP courses (duration of an average of one to three weeks) are customised business and language training programmes. They are designed to fulfill the needs of employers and develop the professional skills of the delegates as well as meeting the challenges of working in an international environment. We offer a range of specialist business programmes for European students and new programmes are continually being developed.

Entry requirements

Depending on the programme, there are different eligibility requirements such as relevant work experience, a completed apprenticeship and/or HE studies.

Applicants should be in employment for the duration of the course. There are no full-time students at ECBM.

An advanced level of English language knowledge is required in order to participate in any programme at the ECBM as the curriculum is entirely delivered in English.
